Important Safety Information



WARNING! POSITION THE SOLARARC SO THAT IT DOES NOT PROVIDE ACCESS TO THE POOL FOR CHILDREN.



WARNING! MOUNT ON GROUND. DO NOT MOUNT ON A ROOF OR STANDING STRUCTURE.

Caution:

The solar heater is designed to be installed on the ground next to your pump and filter system. Please ensure that the installation does not provide children access to the pool. The recommended installation is on the ground and not mounted on a roof or standing structure. Doing so could damage the solar heater and the mounting surface and void your warranty.

Important

- Carefully read this manual. Failure to comply with these instructions can cause injury, death, or damage to the unit.
- Do NOT allow children to operate solar heater
- Always turn the filter system off when installing, working on, or servicing the solar heater
- Install solar heater far enough away from the pool to prevent children from using it as a way to access the pool
- When loosening any threaded connections on your filter, pump or pool, be sure that the filter hoses are closed or blocked to prevent water flow
- Please try to keep all the connection hoses straight

NOTE: Be sure to place your solar blanket on at night to help retain the heat generated by the solar heater.

How solar heater works:

Water flows from your pool's filter into the bottom left corner (inlet) of the solar heater. A plug built into the lower header pipe of the solar heater forces the water up through the left half of the unit. When the water reaches the solar heater upper header pipe, it flows to the right and back down through the right half of the solar heater. As the water travels through the solar heater, it is heated by the sun. The heated water then flows out of the bottom right corner (outlet) of the solar heater and back to your pool.



Where should I put the Solar Heater

- Choose a hard, level surface
- The unit(s) should never be placed on a roof, or any structure
- Install solar heater on the ground in a location where it will receive at least 6 hours of direct sunlight a day
- The unit(s) should be angled toward the sun using the legs provided

NOTE: The solar heater is to be installed between the filter and the pool water inlet. Solar heater must be placed after the filter to prevent buildup of dirt/debris in the tubing.

NOTE: If solar heater needs to be further from the filter than the hoses allow, you may need to purchase a longer hose with the $1\frac{1}{2}$ " diameter openings, or connect 2 hoses together using a $1\frac{1}{2}$ "- $1\frac{1}{2}$ " coupler (not included). In this case make certain you have two hose damps to secure the hoses to the coupler. If the hoses are too wide to fit the hose connector, put the $1\frac{1}{4}$ "- $1\frac{1}{2}$ " tube reducer on the hose connector and continue.

CAUTION

Ensure ALL hoses connections are tight and hoses are NOT kinked or bent at severe angles. If the hoses are leaking, check to make sure ALL of the parts that have O-Rings have them attached and are screwed on tightly. DO NOT over tighten hose clamps.

NOTE: The short rubber hose (see parts photo on parts list under letter J) is only used to connect multiple solar heaters together.


What Tools will I need

• All you need is a flat head screwdriver or 5/16th" nut driver.

When should I run the solar heater

• The solar heater works best when the sun is shining.

Installation

We suggest wrap ample amounts of Teflon tape on the ends of all threaded headers and pipe adapters.

1. Take out solar heater from box, remove the poly bag.



2. Put reducers on two fittings, and install the O-ring.






3. Install the elbow fitting in the center of the heater, fix the other fitting to the inlet, install the C clip.







4. Plug return fitting in pool to ensure no water loss when disconnecting hose from

return.



5. Make sure filter is turned off so no water flows out of the filter when disconnecting return hose from the swimming pool return and connecting to the solar heater.



6. Disconnect flex hose from return fitting.



7. Take the hose end removed from pool return and connect to hose adaptor attached to the header. Tighten hose clamp with screwdriver.




8. Connect provided flex hose to the end labeled "To Pool" and the opposite end to the return fitting. Tighten hose clamp with screwdriver.





9. Unfold the aluminum legs, hold the end, turn counterclockwise to pull the leg to a proper length, and then clockwise turn the leg to fasten it.






10. Place the solar heater in a proper position.



Multiple Solar Heaters Connection

Multiple solar heaters can be installed in series for larger pools and/or for more rapid heating.


- 1. Connect one solar heater's outlet to the other solar heater's inlet with hose, tighten hose clamp with screwdriver.
- 2. Connect the last solar heater's outlet to the pool.



Solar Heater to Pool Connection

We suggest wrap ample amounts of Teflon tape on the ends of all threaded headers and pipe adapters.

- 1. Before the installation please make sure filter is turned off so no water flows out of the filter when disconnecting return hose from the swimming pool return and connecting to the solar heater.
- 2. Please make sure the pool filtration system channel is smooth when using solar heater.
- 3. The picture is for your installation reference.



Winterization:

The solar heater MUST BE DRAINED FOR WINTERIZATION! FREEZE DAMAGE IS NOT COVERED UNDER WARRANTITY! YOU MUST DRAIN THE SOLAR HEATER JUST LIKE YOU DRAIN THE REST OF YOUR POOL EQUIPMENT!

It is always best to store your solar heater inside a warm, dry place for winter storage.

Troubleshooting

Problems	Possibilities/Solutions
Solar heater does not appear to be heating the pool	Make sure that water is flowing through solar heater by checking the flow at the pool return
	Note the weather – has it been cloudy or raining
	Use your pool cover at night to reduce heat loss
	Refer to our order guide – pool size may require additional solar heater
Bubbles continue to appear from the pool water inlet during operation	Check the connections for leaksCheck the flow rate
	Check the tubing for leaks or clogging
Solar heater leaks	Make sure connectors and hose clamps are tight and not defective
