# Background


Steel tongue drums are rooted in philosophy, religion, culture, and art. They are a special blend of contemporary science and technology, vibration theory, and novelty design. Their music is delicate, elegant, and combine the flavor of traditional Chinese musical instruments, such as chimes, guqin, guzheng, and modern hand drums that have strong penetrating power. They are widely used in religion and spiritual practices, such as Buddhism, Confucian, Zen, yoga, Zen Tea, and Sound Healing. The rich tones of the drum can be restorative, helping to clean the mind and spirit.

When attentively playing with the drum, your breathing will regulate to the soft sounds. # Science

The Steel Tongue Drum is a hollow metal body used as a resonating chamber for the sound vibrations released when one or more of the tongues at the top of the drum are struck with your hands or a mallet. The resonating chamber amplifies the sound that is created by tapping the tongues and the sound is released through the opening slits surrounding the tongues. Creation of the pitch is correlated to the size of the resonating chamber. In order to produce the correct sound, the airspace within the drum needs to have the right volume. This volume nees to be right size for the sound wave to complete one full wave for each particular pitch.
