

SAFETY GUIDELINES - DEFINITIONS

WARNING: To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock or injury:


- Do not allow to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- Use only as described in this manual.

- Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors or dropped into water, return it to a service center
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord

appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.

- Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers and all parts of body away from opening and moving parts.
- This appliance is intended for household use only and not for commercial or industrial use.
- Use only in a standard electrical outlet (120V/60Hz).

ASSEMBLE THE BASE TO PUMP



PREPARATION:

🕂 WARNING:

- 1. Always use a properly GFCI protected outlet. (See figure #2)
- 2. The National Electrical Code requires that a Ground Fault Circuit Interrupter (GFCI) be installed in the branch circuit supplying the outlet that this Pump is plugged into.
- 3. Do not immerse plug into water.
- DO NOT REACH INTO WATER TO REMOVE PLUG. TURN OFF CIRCUIT FIRST.
- A drip loop should be provided. The drip loop is a loop in the cord below the level of the receptacle that prevents water from traveling along the cord. (See figure #3)



WARNING:

For your protection always unplug the unit from its power source before installing or servicing. Should the unit appear not to be working DO NOT REACH, REMOVE, or DISASSEMBLE UNIT before you DISCONNECT POWER.

MARNING:

This pump is intended to pump water only. It cannot be used to pump oils, solvents or gasoline.

CARE AND OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS


- This is a submersible, magnetically driven centrifugal pump that is designed specifically for the purpose of removing water off the top of swimming pool covers. Pump should only be used for this aplication.
- This pump is equipped with a collapsible discharge hose used to direct waste water away from the pool.
- This pump is equipped with a pre-filter pad, designed to prevent debris from clogging the pump. This filter pad should be washed clean regularly.
- To avoid permanent damage never run pump dry.

PREPARATION:


- 1. Remove cover pump from box.
- 2. Unwind cord making sure that the plug stays dry at all times.
- 3. Make sure hose is securely clamped to the pump.
- 4. Submerge the pump in the deepest area of water on your winter cover.
- 5. Direct the open end of the hose away from the pool.
- 6. Plug in the pump.

ROUTINE MAINTENANCE:


- 1. Filter pad should be replaced annually.
- 2. Remove pump from pool after each use.
- 3. Disconnect and drain garden hose.
- 4. Remove, clean and replace filter pad after each use




Remove Four Screws

▲ CAUTION:

To avoid damaging pump never leave pump submerged in water that may freeze. Allowing ice to form inside the pump chamber will permanently damage the pump.
