

WARNING: THE SOLAR COVER IS NOT A SAFETY DEVICE. THE SOLAR COVER IS NOT DESIGNED TO SUPPORT THE WEIGHT OF A PERSON OR PETS. It is possible to drown on top of the Solar Cover. The Solar Cover must be removed before swimming. Children should be supervised in order to assure that the Solar Cover has been completely removed. It is possible to get caught under the Solar Cover and drown if the Cover is not properly removed from the pool or spa before swimming.

INSTALLATION: THE SOLAR POOL COVER IS INSTALLED ON THE POOL OR SPA WITH THE BUBBLES FACING **DOWN AND THE SMOOTH SIDE UP.** To ensure proper fitting, the cover should be left floating in the pool or spa for 2 to 4 days to remove the packaging creases. Before cutting the cover, make an outline of your pool shape with a marker on your solar cover. Exercise caution when cutting your solar cover to fit around curves and angles of your pool or spa; scissors or other cutting devices may damage pool liners. The solar cover can be cut easily with household scissors to fit the angles and curves of the pool walls. For all types of pools and spas, remove the cover from the pool after making the outline and begin trimming. It is better to cut the cover larger than necessary, and then give it a final trimming for an exact fit after a day or two. Once the cover is cut correctly, it should not require ties or weights to keep it in place. With the bubble side facing down, your solar pool cover should float in place on the water through wind and heavy rains. Please note: bubbles on your cover are not fully inflated, this is normal. Over time, through sun exposure, the bubbles will heat up and expand.

Maintenance & Care: It is important that you follow these instructions in order to ensure that your warranty remains valid.

- 1. Protect the Cover While Swimming: The Solar Cover MUST be protected from the sunlight when it is removed from the pool. The best way to protect your Solar Cover is to place it in the shade or cover it with a blanket cover when the Solar Cover is not in use. DELAMINATION DUE TO IMPROPER EXPOSURE OF THE SOLAR COVER TO DIRECT SUNLIGHT (WHEN NOT IN USE / WHEN STORED OFF THE POOL) WILL RESULT IN VOIDING THE WARRANTY!
- 2. Care in Handling: To prevent damage to the Solar Cover, the Cover should be carefully lifted over abrasive pool decks, coping or any sharp or ragged surface.
- 3. High Temperatures: Water temperatures above 90° F may shorten the life of your Solar Cover. If pool temperatures rise above 90° F the Solar Cover should be removed. SOLAR COVER WILL NOT BE COVERED UNDER WARRANTY IF THE COVER IS USED ON SPAS AND OR POOLS IN WHICH TEMPERATURES EXCEED 90° F. Your Solar Cover should not be stored in an area where temperatures might reach 120° F. COVER DEFECTS CAUSED BY EXPOSING THE COVER TO THE SUN OR EXCESSIVE HEAT WHILE OFF THE POOL (AS DISCUSSED ABOVE) ARE NOT COVERED BY THE WARRANTY.
- 4. Cleaning: A clean Solar Cover is more efficient than a dirty one and will allow more of the sun's rays to pass through the Cover to heat your pool water. Use Rx Clear® Vinyl Cleaner Item #201348 to clean your Cover. To keep your pool cleaner, promptly dispose of dirt and debris after hosing off the dirt and leaves from the floating Solar Cover.
- 5. Storage: Clean your Solar Cover and allow it to dry thoroughly to prevent mildew. Fold it on the seams and roll it from one end. Place the Cover in a clean, dry, rodent-free area where temperatures will NOT reach 120° F. DO NOT leave your Solar Cover on the pool after the swimming season ends. A solar cover is not a winter cover and its life may be severely shortened by winter conditions.
- 6. Chemicals: Your Solar Cover should be removed periodically in order to ensure that there is no damage caused by chemical usage. The level of chorine should be monitored to make sure it does not rise above 3 parts per million (PPM). If you must raise the chlorine level to more than 3 PPM, then remove your Solar Cover from the pool to extend the useful life of the Cover. Before you Super Chlorinate your pool, the cover must be removed and kept off for an extended period of time. DAMAGE CAUSED BY EXCESSIVE CHLORINE EXPOSURE IS EXCLUDED FROM THIS WARRANTY.

Your Solar Cover is guaranteed by the manufacturer to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal use in accordance with the Manufacture's Installation and Use Instructions. The only conditions covered under this Warranty are delamination (except stated below) and seam failure.

This Warranty does not apply to damage to the cover and its bubbles resulting from accident, misuse or abuse of the product (including punctures, rips and tears), alteration or modification of the product after your purchase, or chemical damage or delamination caused by sun exposure or excessive heat while the cover is off the spa or pool or excessive chlorine exposure.

THIS WARRANTY IS IN LIEU OF ALL OTHER EXPRESS WARRANTIES TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW ARE DISCLAIMED ALL OTHER WARRANTIES AND CONDITIONS, EXPRESS OR IMPLIED, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE IMPLIED WARRANTIES OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. REPLACEMENT OF DEFECTIVE PRODUCTS AS PROVIDED UNDER THIS WARRANTY IS YOUR EXCLUSIVE REMEDY. THE MANUFACTURER WILL NOT BE LIABLE IN CONTRACT OR TORT FOR ANY DIRECT, CONSEQUENTIAL, SPECIAL OR INCIDENTAL LOSS, INJURY OR DAMAGE ARISING OUT OF THE USE, MISUSE OR INABILITY TO USE THIS PRODUCT. THIS WARRANTY IS NOT TRANSFERABLE BY THE ORIGINAL OWNER TO A SUBSEQUENT OWNER OF THE SOLAR COVER.

Some states do not allow the exclusion or limitation of incidental or consequential damages, so the above limitation or exclusion may not apply to you. This Warranty gives you specific legal rights, and you may have additional rights, which vary from state to state.

The purchaser shall pay for the following percent of the list price at the time of replacement and shall be responsible for any handling or shipment fee for replacement, including additional shipping charges for oversized covers.
